

Strolling on the River: Trump Tower opens walkway between Michigan Avenue & Loop

Walk this way, says Donald Trump, The Trump International Hotel & Tower Chicago at 401 N. Wabash advises that its riverwalk is now open.

This was supposed to be the building's way of drawing pedestrians between North Michigan Avenue and the Loop, sort of what the old Sun-Times Building used to do, albeit in more utilitarian fashion.

Passersby can admire the Jerusalem Gold limestone and a water lily pond. They are among the features in the 92-story building's 1.2-acre riverfront park.

The tables and umbrellas are not yet out but will be this summer.
