

**Destination: CHICAGO – “Trump the Deal”**

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When Donald Trump gets behind something, luxury is always the defining factor. Where Wacker Drive meets Wabash Avenue along the Chicago River, something supremely decadent has recently opened. It's 92 stories of luxury suites – with 600 – 1,000 square feet each – inside Trump International Hotel & Tower Chicago.

Anyone who stays here books a table at Sixteen (aptly named for its 16<sup>th</sup>-floor location) and likely orders the six-course tasting menu (\$82, or \$130 with wine). True foodies opt for the “blind” tasting (\$110/\$180), all orchestrated by Executive Chef Frank Brunacci.

Rebar, adjacent to Sixteen and with equally impressive skyline views, has a line of seasonal punches (\$115 to \$235 or \$12 - \$17 a glass) on its menu.

Don't miss a treatment in the 23,000 square feet of bliss at The Spa at Trump, where its health club has machines that emit signature scents (pine or citrus anyone?) while others were designed by Ferrari.
